THE EXHIBITION- TERMS & GUIDELINES

(Organiser = Svenska Bergteknikföreningen, Venue = Stockholmsmässan)

1 Terms of order

Booking of exhibition stand is done via an ordering form on the website www.omnex.se. Registration is binding and entails an obligation to pay corresponding fees to the Swedish Rock Engineering Association.

The organiser reserves the right to make adjustments in the distribution of the exhibition spaces that are conditioned by a rational use of the premises. Sharing or trading all or part of the leased space is not permitted without prior consent of the organiser.

Exhibitor's cancellation of order does not entail exemption from the obligation to pay the fees, other than after written agreement with the organiser.

2 In- and outloading

The exhibition area is available for inloading and construction 2026-03-02 from 11:00 to 18:00 o'clock. (Special agreement with the venue applies when moving in large machines.)

The exhibition stand may not be dismantled or otherwise removed during the conference. All exhibited items etc must be removed from the venue 2026-03-03 no earlier than 16:30 o'clock but no later than 20:00 o'clock, otherwise the venue have the right to arrange for removal and the cost will be charged to the exhibitor.

3 Extended and/or other services

One power outlet (230V 10A) with a power strip is included per stand. Stand walls are only provided at certain locations. The venue contacts exhibitors with the necessary information and offers for their extended services. Orders must be placed well in advance of the event and charged according to the venue's current price list or according to quotation. Orders for extended services must be received by the venue no later than 28 days before the date of entry. Orders placed later than 28 days before the date of entry will be charged with a surcharge of 30% of the current price list. Orders made from the date of entry will be charged with a surcharge of 50% of the current price list. The organiser is not responsible for any separate agreements signed between the exhibitor and the venue.

4 Genreal terms

Exhibitors are obliged to follow the organiser's and the venue's instructions and regulations within the exhibition area. Exhibitors are obliged to submit to the changes in location and space that are called for by the circumstances. The exhibition stand must not exceed the rented space in neither length, width nor height. Specified dimensions are approximate. For information about exact dimensions of the allocated space, requests for installations higher than 2.5 m or when exhibiting large machines, exhibitors must contact the venue for information and permit.

Exhibition equipment may not be attached to the existing facade or interior without the venue's consent. When using tape to attach, for example, carpets, this must be of a type that does not cause damage to the interior when removed, which must be

taken care of by the exhibitor.

Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that emergency exits are not blocked and that all equipment, cords and the like are placed so that they do not pose any risk or obstacle in case of the need to evacuating the premises.

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the cost of transport, set-up, dismantling, etc of their exhibit. Installation of working machines (does not apply to personal computers or similar), construction of larger structures and / or painting is not allowed without prior agreement with the organiser and the venue.

Alcoholic beverages may not be served, used or stored within the premises of the venue other than those that may be served of the organiser. The venue's designated supplier has the exclusive right regarding all sales and serving of food and beverages in their premises. Exhibitors may not sell/serve/offer food nor beverages in the premises used by the organiser or in other parts of the venue holder's premises. Sweets and snacks are allowed in smaller form. The venue is responsible for the general cleaning in the premises, and exhibitors are responsible for the cleaning of their rented space.

The venue's facilities and equipment are insured against fire. The venue has third-party liability insurance. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that all products and equipment brought to the venue are insured and do not pose a risk of fire or the like. The venue owner and the organiser are not responsible for the exhibitor's property or obligations. Exhibitors are solely responsible for having the necessary insurances regarding their commitments and their property.

Exhibitors are responsible for damages or loss caused by him or his representatives in the exhibition premises as well as damages or loss as a consequence of exhibitor's negligence. The venue provides necessary security surveillance, but does not assume any responsibility for exhibited products or other equipment, nor insurance of any kind. The organiser accepts no responsibility for exhibited items or material.

5 Force Majeure

In case of war, strike, special measures by the state, municipality, local authorities or similar, lockout, fire, pandemics or other similar circumstances the organiser may be forced to cancel or shut down the exhibition without being liable for any refunds nor responsibility for costs, loss or damage of any kind that exhibitors may suffer thereof.

6 Special circumstances

Should there be restrictions that make it impossible to carry out the conference, Bergdagarna will, if possible, be moved forward in time. No guarantees are given that the same venue and/or venue holder will be used.

7 Other

Photographing and film recording may take place during Bergdagarna, and may be published on the organiser's various websites and social media and in other marketing channels.
